Action Plan:

· Solution to finding the website -

Poster will be placed inside schools with the link to the YouTube video, users will access the teaser trailer with the websites link on the end of it. Poster will be old fashioned 1940s style. Team member needs to create poster.

Solution to the puzzles –

Once users have accessed the poster and YouTube. On the website, the blurry images of the characters will have a link to each character's profile page on Instagram with the tagline "who am 1?", then Users will be greeted with the Instagram profile of the character. The Instagram profile will have the blurry image, the user will be greeted with 9 images making up one giant picture that said character has said they were in. In the bio, it will be the link to the podcast with a riddle pertaining to the character. Team member needs to chop and create the nine images and blurry images.

Solution to amount of Characters -

7 characters in total: Rodger, Ralph, Jack, Piggy, Simon and Sam & Eric. Naval officer will have no image but will have his link at the bottom and a quote that he said when he found them. Coder will fix the layout of this and create it, images will be taken from the designer and coded.

Solution to the app –

App will be changed to a mobile responsive app. The link will be on top of the website and when clicked it will be a 360-panorama imagery that users can scroll around and explore the website. Coder and photographer will oversee this.

· Solution to Social Media issue-

Generic Remote Pacific Facebook page for quotes and updates. Coder will address this.

Week 1 - Group Meeting

Remote Pacific

New poster and YouTube video idea- Posters will be put into schools for audiences to be connected to the YouTube video that showcases the teaser of the unidentified people that will lead them to the website. A cliff hanger for the audience to figure out what happens and would have to click the link to bring them to the main site for them to explore the identities of the characters. This is a solution for how people will find out about the site.

Instagram- From the website there are blurry photos of the characters 20 years after the incident and above them is links to Instagram profile of the unidentified character with their feed having a lot of images that make one large image/scene. They are all posted on different days. Each with a quote from the person in the book so they can guess who it is, but if they can't in the bio is a riddle with a question of "who am I?" and then a link that sends the user to a website that hosts the podcast that link them to the character whose Instagram they were on.

Characters-There are 6 Character photos online but then there will be a quote and link to a naval officer that will lead you to his testimony through podcasts. The individual characters will tell of their experience on the island and the user can create their own opinion on the character. The characters podcasts will reveal the different themes of the book and their thoughts on the beast.

The app to a responsive mobile site-There will be 360 explorations of the island where the user can click on the pop-up boxes that will tell them of where the character was and what they did in the location.

Facebook and Instagram-The Facebook and Instagram will just link the user to the island and see what it was like through photos and quotes and updates. This is for location awareness for the user to get a sense of the island.



2) Then the colour was changed to match the instagram pictures, the "spherize" otiton was then added to add the curves to the sides.




 Finally, the edges weres motthed out and then added into the marzipano tool online.







simon

The ship was heading East across the pacific, we had been sailing for 2 weeks and on high alert. The ship sailed above the horizon and a cloud of smoke drifted in the distance, where is that coming from? smoke in the middle of the remote pacific? something was wrong.

The captain decided that this was no coincidence, and so we sailed toward the grey haze. When we reached the shore it was like something had ravaged through what seemed a peaceful quaint land. Fire, blood and savagery a combination found in nightmares and for such young boys such savageness ran through their veins.

Taking them from this world of primitive nature an unnerving story unfolded. School children murdering each other , that was no survival technique that was thirst for power and blood. but one story that gave me shivers down my back was the one of young simon. A skinny boy who works for the good of others, although different to the others boys he was the one to recognise the true effect of the beast.

No beast roamed this land, no physical creature with claws or fangs, the horror lived within these boys. And the irony was, simon was ordered by the savagery of the boys before he could reveal the true nature of the beast, these boys have no civilisation or remorse left.

It was a long flight, the plane loud and buzzing with the noise of all the boys, especially the littluns. I had a seat at the window, i could see the vast blue ocean and the small glimpses of golden sand as we passed the scatter of tiny islands. A thump, chaos swept over the plane, screaming and crying from everyone, but not me. I knew danger was always present especially as we were at war.

The impact of the plane into the water was frightening, water quickly rising and the hysterics of these boys was deafening.

We swam across these unknown waters to what we thought, at the time, was a safe haven, a tropical island in the remote pacific.

I knew that we would have to survive alone here but what I didn't expect was the bloodshed and carnage that surfaced. I took control, as an older boy it was my duty, you know these littleuns had no skills, just helpless children at the end of the day. I protected those boys I did my best, I did myself proud over them weeks, you try and control savages.

It was that day, that changed all the boys but our minds were taken by the savagery and primitive instinct. I climbed castle rock, it took me ages with the little strength i had, but i would do whatever to take control of what was mine, i was the leader. I pushed on it, the log jammed and became a lever, i used my power to move that boulder and that was how it happened, the boulder surged down the rock, and killed him. Yes it was me i killed him i killed piggy, but he was asking for it.

Thinking back I do have regrets the bloodthirst i had was unimaginable from the outside but it captured me. I cant change the past , whats happened is done and thats that.

12 hundred on the 3rd of may, she sailed west across the pacific ocean, t minus 4 hours until dock. A cold wind swept over the top of her, but no cloud in sight, a warning of a danger to come.

I stood at the bow, she was a mighty ship, kept us safe through all sorts of weather, all conditions, done us men proud. Captian Thomas was an eagle eyes man, always those spectacles on and cigar in hand, oh how I would love to go back to those days.

but it was captain thomas who spotted it, a gust of smoke, thick and black arising from an island 140 degrees south, you don't see something like that very often in the middle of the remote pacific, we sailed onward following the smokey haze.

A blazing fire engulfed the coast, i saw footprints as a walked along the sandy beach front, no one could survive this environment, especially no one with those footprints, small children.

It was then that a boy ran from inside the scorched forest, covered in blood, soot and terror, he collapsed at my foot.

When we got these boys onto the ship , that was when the truth started to unfold. Savage, no other term can be used to describe what fell upon my ears that day. Hunting, murder, arson and tribes, what brought these young english men to commit such horrid acts of evil, i still don't know. I think about it now and then and it seems a dream, a fiction of my imagination, but no this was all truth and to be honest I don't know how any of them could continue their everyday life knowing what torture they instilled upon each other on that vast, murderous, remote pacific island.
